F.I.M.I. – E.B.A.R. OF ROME AND ITS PROVINCE

REGULATION APPLICATION FOR FUNERAL ALLOWANCE

The Management Committee of the F.I.M.I.- E.B.A.R. of Rome and its Province resolves, on an annual basis, to allocate a variable amount for the payment of a contribution for the funeral allowance in favour of the heirs of agricultural workers and farm owners of Rome and its Province.

For the current year, it has allocated the total sum of € 10,000.00 (Euro Ten Thousand/00), subject to availability of funds, for a total of 10 cheques to be reserved for 5 workers (OTI and OTD) and 5 employers of farms.

AMOUNTS DISBURSED

The amount set for each individual event is € 1,000.00 (Euro One Thousand/00) net, subject to availability of funds.

BENEFICIARIES:

- Permanent agricultural workers (OTI) employed, at the time of the event, by farms in Rome and its Province, whose employers are up to date with the payment of FIMI contributions. E.B.A.R.;
- Temporary agricultural workers (OTD) employed on farms up to date with the payment of F.I.M.I. E.B.A.R. contributions in Rome and its Province, registered in the registry lists in the two-year period preceding the application for <u>at least 51 days</u>;
- Owners of active farms at the time of the event who are up to date with their FIMI contribution payments. E.B.A.R.

APPLICATION AND SUBMISSION DEADLINES:

the application must be submitted, using the form available for download at www.fimiroma.it, filled in completely (front/back), within 90 days of the death.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

- 1) death certificate
- 2) family status
- 3) declaration by the employer stating the existence of the employment relationship at the time of the event or declaration by the company heirs (who was the owner).
- 4) substitute declaration for affidavit certifying the identity of the heirs
- 5) power of attorney in favour of one of the heirs (in the case of several heirs) with authenticated signature
- 6) authorisation of the tutelary judge in the case of a minor heir.

Important Note

Funeral allowances will be paid out at the end of the calendar year, subject to availability of funds.

If the number of applications submitted by the deadline exceed the number fixed annually, the Management Committee of the F.I.M.I.- E.B.A.R. of Rome and its Province, at its sole discretion, will draw up a ranking list based on the following criteria:

- 1. family income of everyone in the family status;
- 2. family load as per tax certification.
